1st Quarter Event Schedule

2019-1, Saturday, Jan. 19, Eagle Days @ Starved Rock

Meet at 8:00 AM at the Cracker Barrel rear parking lot in Morton for carpooling (**be on time**). Those traveling directly should meet us at the front door of the Lodge at 9:30 AM. Bathrooms are available at the Lodge. The club is bundling up and creating our own bald eagle

watch/hike at Starved Rock. This is always a good time regardless of season or eagle appearances. There will be stairs on the trails. Weather and footing will determine the distance we take as options for trails exist. Dress appropriately for the cold temperature. Wear boots and bring your hiking poles. If it is icy and you have some sort of ice cleats/spikes bring them. Bring water, camera, trail snack, and binoculars as you wish. Leashed dogs are welcome. Following the hike, as an option, we will eat at the Lodge or in Utica. Directions to Starved Rock: go North on I39, take exit 48 at Tonica, turn right (East) onto N 20th Rd, come to a T and turn left (North) on Route 178, go several miles, turn right into the park at the sign & drive up the hill to the Lodge, turn off on your left.
